JOB SUMMARY:

Responsible for the assembly, maintenance, repair, adjustment and installation of heating, water and drainage systems in both commercially and residential buildings. This position may provide guidance and training to any apprentices. Some experience is beneficial but not entirely necessary. Willing to train the right candidate. Plumbers are required to adhere to all safe practices mandated by the state, federal government, OSHA standards and Bantam Wesson policies. Depending on the current project, Plumbers may need to be flexible with regards to shift, overtime or weekend hours. Plumbers are required to have the following the minimum tools: electrical hand tools, meter, and battery drill. Plumbers will be working on site both residentially and commercially. For those reasons, it is expected to maintain a clean work area at all times. Should a plumber take home a company vehicle, they will be expected to respond to any emergency service calls.

Essential functions:

Install and repair water, drain pipes • Install and repair well, sewage and sump pumps • Snake drains and sewers • Install pipe assemblies, fittings, valves, appliances such as dishwashers and water heaters, and fixtures such as sinks and toilets, using hand and power tools. • Practice safe standards observing OSHA protocols and Bantam Wesson policies • Locate and mark the position of pipe installations, connections, passage holes, and fixtures in structures, using measuring instruments such as rulers and levels. • Must exercise customer service skills with customers and contractors, consisting of explaining work performed, speak knowledgeably of how to resolve issues and exercise patience with the public • Other duties as requested

Working Conditions:

Plumbers, pipefitters, and steamfitters work in factories, homes, businesses, and other places where there are pipes or septic systems. Plumbers and fitters lift heavy materials, climb

ladders, and work in tight spaces. Some plumbers travel to a variety of worksites every day. A few work outdoors, even in bad weather.
